

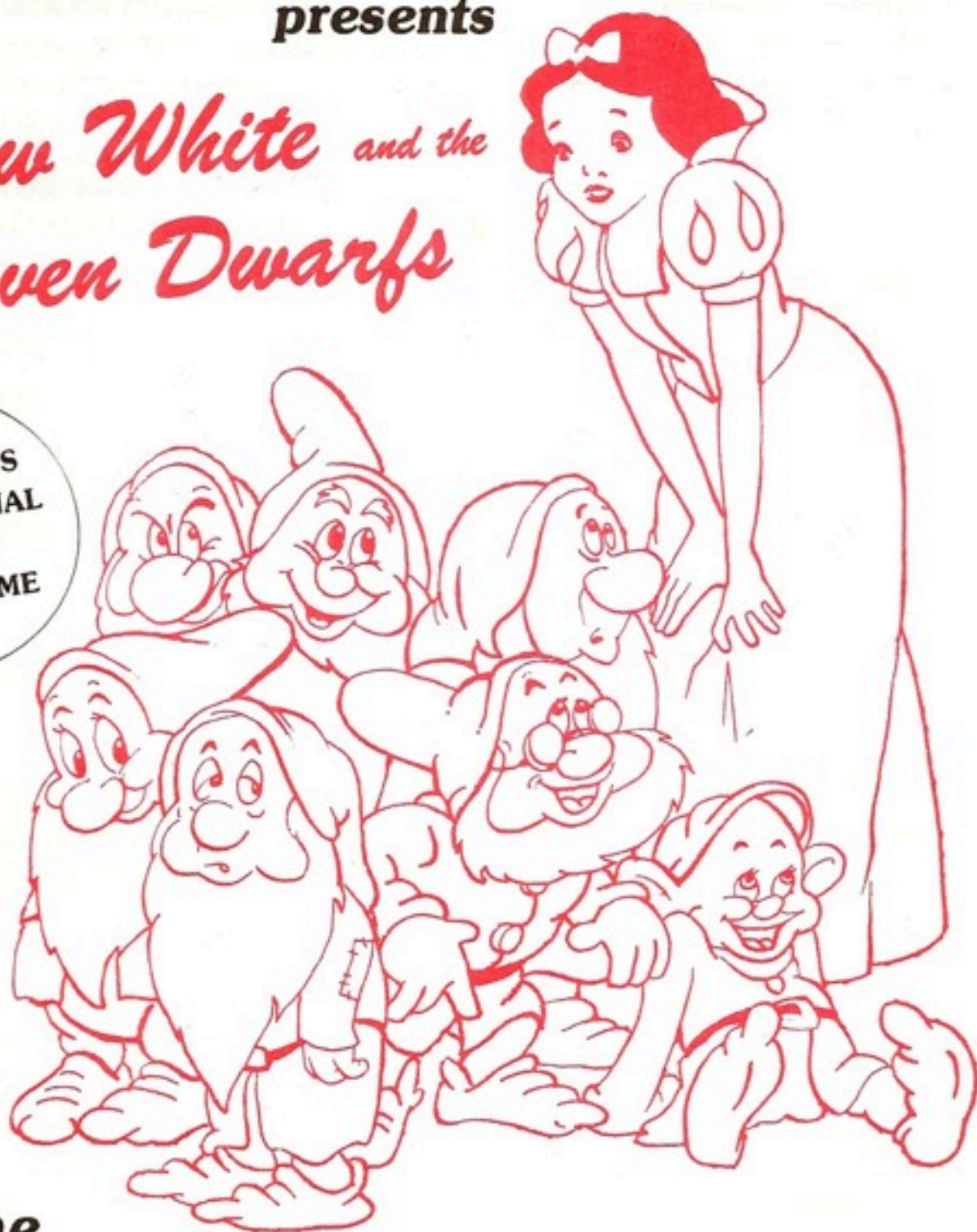

She meets Prince Valentine whilst he is staying at the Palace of the Queen.

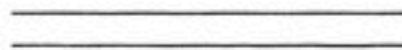
The Queen feels that she should be the most beautiful woman in the land but the magic mirror tells her otherwise.
